## Ready for some serious fun?

Riding is believing! The 20" wheel slice folding bike is a pure blast to ride! Picture quick-starting to a high speed instantly – no big wheel inertia to overcome, dodging all obstacles on your commute, or zigzagging through other students on the way to class. Picture riding circles around your kids or blowing by someone on a bike fitness trail – now that's satisfaction. This bike really handles!

The melon slice takes riding simplicity to the next level. The slice is designed with an extra large front chainring that provides the gear ratios necessary to conquer any terrain with only 8 gears. The SRAM MRX Pro grip shifter makes shifting intuitive and fun and includes a numerical display that shows your gear selection at a glance. The seat is comfortable but firm and the rear mounted kickstand is out of the way until you need it. High quality rims and high-powered V-brakes round out the design. Its upright riding position makes for an enjoyable day in the saddle.

The slice is made from lightweight 7005 aluminum and is easily transported in the trunk of the car, brought along to the office or classroom, carried into a restaurant, taken on vacation, stored in an RV or boat, or kept in an apartment closet. But, you don't have to sacrifice performance for portability. You'll soon think of your slice as a bike that folds, not a folding bike.
